The word unlike struck me in a different sort of way. It made me think of Jesus.

Maybe that sounds strange but He's unlike anyone else. I contemplated the things about Jesus that make Him so special and set Him apart from any other person you could ever know in life.

He's unlike us in many ways yet shared in our humanity by becoming flesh. He shared in the sufferings of mankind. He understands our struggles and our pain.

The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit. Psalm 34:18 (NIV)

Have you ever had your heart broken or your spirit crushed? It *really* hurts.
